

Disclosure about transferability of credit

- a) No person, agent or group entity of whatever kind, alone or in concert with others, shall operate in this state a postsecondary educational institution unless, prior to a student signing an enrollment contract or agreement, the institution provides any prospective student a written disclosure about transferability of credits in the form set in subdivision
- b) 1) the disclosure required by this section shall be on a document containing no other disclosures and shall be printed in a type not less than sixteen point font. The student shall initial and date a copy of the written information to indicate that the student was given the required disclosure prior to executing an enrollment contract or agreement.

2) the disclosure on the transferability of credits shall be as followed

Credit earned at Nashville Barber and Style Academy may not transfer to another educational institution may not be acceptable by Nashville Barber and Style Academy. You should obtain confirmation that Nashville Barber and Style Academy will accept any credits you have earned at another educational institution before you execute an enrollment agreement. You should also contact any educational institutions that you may want to transfer credits earned at Nashville Barber and Style Academy to determine if such institutions will accept credits earned at Nashville Barber and Style Academy prior to executing an enrollment contract or agreement. The ability to transfer credits from Nashville Barber and Style Academy to another educational institution may be very limited. Your credit may not transfer and you may have to repeat courses previously taken at Nashville Barber and Style Academy if you enroll in another educational institution. It is highly recommended and you are advised to make certain that you know the transfer of credit policy of Nashville Barber and Style Academy and any other educational institutions you may in the future want to transfer the credit earned at Nashville Barber and Style Academy before you executed an enrollment contract or agreement.

C) if a postsecondary institution does not require a student to sign an enrollment contract or agreement, then information on how to obtain the institution's transfer of credit policy shall be included in the letter of acceptance or other such document sent by the postsecondary institution to the student. The information shall be sent to the student prior to the institution's requesting any payment from the student other than an application fee or a housing deposit.
